



Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
between
the International Occupational Hygiene Association (IOHA)
and
the International Society for Respiratory Protection (ISRP)

1. The IOHA and the ISRP (hereafter Partners) exchange this MOU with the aim of extending mutual understanding and friendship and developing scientific and engineering communication between the two Partners within the limits of their aims, strategies and resources.
2. The cooperation and collaboration among the Partners aim to share knowledge at national, international and global levels to enhance occupational safety and health by promoting research, standards development, provision of guidance and the facilitation and promotion of training.
3. Both Partners will encourage and promote the active exchange of scientific information in the field of occupational hygiene, with the focus on respiratory protection.
4. To encourage collaboration between the two Partners, each Partner agrees on the following sub-items, which are intended to maximize the beneficial results from the collaboration.
 - a) Promote exchange of information covering occupational hygiene, with the focus on respiratory protection.
 - b) Development of mutual friendships, collaboration and cooperation between the members of each Partner and special committees.
 - c) Facilitate and promote cooperative research, standards development and establishment of guidance in an environment of mutual interest.
 - d) Facilitate and promote collaboration in the field of training and education
5. Both Partners will review the ongoing progress of this MOU via electronic communications or actual meetings on an annual basis.
6. Both Partners respect the fundamental agreement of this MOU with its effectiveness under the spirit of friendship and equality.
7. The financing of activities under this MOU will be subject to the available funds and human resources available to the two Partners. In principle all forms of collaboration shall be carried out on a self-sustaining basis unless otherwise agreed.
8. Each Partner may terminate this MOU by providing a written notice to this effect to the other Partner.
9. This MOU is prepared formally in English and becomes effective upon signing by both Partners' presidents.
